

Cookies Policy

The Company may use cookies to give the best possible experience when visiting the Company's website, to help improve the website's services, and to further optimize its functionality and improve security. We respect your privacy, and we are committed to ensuring that you are adequately informed on how you can manage your cookies.

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of information. When you visit a website, the website sends the cookie to your computer. Your computer stores it in a file located inside your web browser. We may obtain information about you by accessing cookies sent by our website. Cookies help us to verify your identity and detect the Country you are currently visiting from, checking browser type and device, and to track which site the user was referred from.

Types of cookies

We might use different types of cookies that each of them keeps track of different activities.

Functional cookies: We use functional cookies to analyse how visitors and clients use our website, as well as track and improve our website's performance and function. This allows us to provide a high-quality customer experience by quickly identifying and fixing any issues that may arise. For example, we might use cookies to keep track of which website pages are most popular and which method of linking between website pages is most effective.

Analytical cookies: The information provided by analytical cookies allows us to analyse patterns of visitor and client behaviour and we use that information to enhance the overall experience or identify areas of the website which may require maintenance. The information is anonymous (i.e. it cannot be used to identify you and does not contain personal information such as your name and email address), and it is only used for



statistical purposes. Behavioural cookies are similar to analytical and remember that you have visited the website and use that information to provide you with content which is tailored to your interests.

Performance Cookies: Cookies provided by Google Analytics, these enable us to provide a better service based on how our users navigate our website.

You can always refuse cookies on your computer by changing the browser settings. How you do this depends on the browser you're using. If you use more than one browser, you must delete cookies in each browser.
